

"Important Information About the RFC"

#### What to know about filling out the "Request for Change" (RFC):


- When filling out the "Request For Change" (RFC), please <u>be specific</u>. Do <u>not use</u> "<u>maybe</u> we will..." or "we will do (this) <u>or</u> (that)". <u>We need to know exactly what</u> <u>you plan to do (i.e., "We will plant a Cherry Tree in the front yard 5' from the driveway and 8' from the curb.").</u>
- If you <u>change your mind</u> either on doing the project, or about part of the project, you must inform the Architectural Committee <u>in advance</u> of actually making those changes.
- If you <u>need more time</u> than the four (4) months that we give you to finish the project, let the Committee know, and we will give you the extended time you need.
- When the project is finished, take the <u>yellow Permit</u> out of your window and sign the back of it; then, turn it in to the Front Office. The Committee will then drive by and praise you for a great job and for improving our community through your new project. If the project is not finished in the way you specified on the RFC, the Committee will not approve the project and will notify you in writing why. You then can either make the necessary changes, or you may appeal to the Board of Directors to avoid a possible fine. If you work with us, we will work with you to help you accomplish your project according to the Rules of our Villages At Lynx Creek.
- Also, *This is very important*: If you are having *someone other than yourselves* do the work, and you want them to represent you to the Committee, **tell us, on the RFC**, who will do the work, and give us a phone number. The Architectural Committee is allowed to deal *only with you, the owner* of the Lot *or* the owner's specified "contractor" (whoever will be doing the work) if permission is given in writing.

We, on the Architectural Committee, wish each of you a Wonderful and blessed Holiday season! Be safe, and we look forward to seeing you next year.


