## Election of Board of Directors

Dave appointed Jane to select six homeowners in good standing to be the Ballot Counting Committee. The Election Committee was scheduled to meet again mid-May for an update. A change in the Chairperson of the Election Committee "happened" and Vice President Chuck Merritt became Chairperson on the committee.

In the mean time, applications were being accepted in the office as of April 1st. However, with the lack of experience and knowledge things progressed slowly. Application cut-off was May 8th. The Election Committee met on May 9th to go over all applications received for eligibility and resumes. Three applications were received and were eligible.

The ballots will be sent out US mail. At this time we will be accepting completed sealed ballots at the office in the envelope provide in the packet. They will be put into the Ballot Box after the receipt of the ballot is acknowledged.

The 2020 Annual Meeting and Election of Directors will be on July 8, 2020 at 2:00p.m. The final opportunity to vote is 11:00 a.m. Vote counting will begin at 11:30 a.m. Results will be announced at the Annual Meeting in the Social Hall.

## ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE NEWS

### "PLEASE PLAN AHEAD!"

*By Rick for the Architectural Committee*

- Well, with the *Wuhan Virus* (COVID-19) keeping us all in “quarantine” these days, it seems that everyone is itching to get outside and do something. And doing something may mean making improvements to the outside of the house or the yards (or playing golf??).
- When improving our lots, don't forget to submit an RFC (Request For Change) to the Architectural Committee first – *before* starting the project.
- HOWEVER – because of the “quarantine” the Committee isn't meeting as usual, but we ARE covering the RFCs. This means that our work of processing the RFCs may be a bit slower than usual; so, PLEASE PLAN AHEAD – *try not to wait until just before you want to start your project to submit the RFC*. Probably submitting the RFC two or three weeks ahead would be good.
- If your project is considered an *emergency work*, please make a note of that at the top of the RFC, and we will get yours cleared as soon as possible.
- After we have issued you the Villages' Yellow Permit, please display it so that it can be seen from the street (in a window is fine).
  - You will have up to 4 months to complete the project. Extension of time is available if needed.
  - When you have finished your project(s), sign the back of the Yellow Permit and return it to the office.
- Once it is safe for us all to meet together again normally, this process of approving the RFCs will be expedited more quickly.

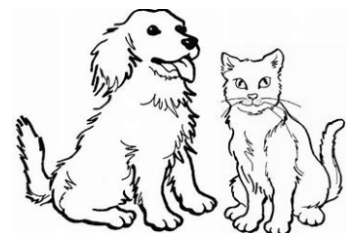
