# MANAGER'S REPORT

## Manager's Report

August 2023

It has been a very busy time in the office with all of our residents enjoying the summer. At our last Meet the Manager Meeting the focus was on the proposed Fain Project, Clipper Courts. Steve Breyer and Bob Loskill attended at my invitation to explain the proposed project.. The minutes of that meeting (all 8 pages, oh my aching fingers) was sent out via email. Copies are available in the office should you wish to read.

The Sub Committee is working hard on the plan for the old Bocce Ball court and they have some great ideas. The top ideas are shade, putting green, shuffleboard, firepit and artificial turf seating area.

Steve and Bob answered with what they knew. They only know that Fain has proposed an "open age" community of 49 manufactured homes ranging from park models to 3-bedroom homes that may be purchased or leased but the land will only be leased (like Orchard Ranch). The reason that Fain came to us is that the Prescott Valley Board of Adjustment would have to grant a Use Agreement to Fain for this proposal. The members of the Board that were present at this initial meeting, Steve Breyer, Bob Loskill, Sandra Hoffman and Al Myers, then proposed a compromise to Fain. If they would restrict their Community to 55+, The Board would go back to the Villages Residents and propose a limited use agreement to use the Villages Common Area facilities.;

The main concern of our residents seemed to be:

1. Children visiting (vandalizing) our community
2. More traffic on our streets
3. Monitoring these visitors
4. Negotiating with Fain – "David vs. Goliath" – asking for a professional negotiator.
5. Property Values
6. The consequences of a proposed limited use agreement with Clipper Courts to incentivize a 55+:
  - a. Who would monitor?
  - b. Would the user have access to the compactor?
  - c. Would the management at Clipper Courts assure that there are no more than 2 people in each unit?
  - d. Limiting use to Common Area (excluding Social Hall and no sign up for activities)?
  - e. Access to the Dog Park?
  - f. Use of the Tennis and Pickle Ball Courts?
  - g. Damage to our Common Area

## WHY DO WE HAVE AN ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

### What can the Architectural Committee do for homeowners?

So, now that we know why the Association has guidelines, how can the committee help homeowners? While it may seem arbitrary from an individual homeowner's standpoint, the architectural committee looks out for the entire community. Aside from stopping residents from painting pink polka dots on their houses, the committee's job is to make sure that the size and style of the project, the type of building materials being used, and the overall look of the new structure adhere to the community design requirements that were in place when the community was started.

Not only does this keep the community looking cohesive, but it also helps to keep property values up by preventing individual structures from standing out. It's also important to note that unapproved structures might legally have to be removed at the owner's expense, so it's better to just have them get approval before building in the first place.

So, when a homeowner is ready to start a new project, or if the design of a current project changes midway through building it, plans must be sent to the architectural committee first to make sure they're in compliance with the Association's design standards. If the committee does find any issues, they will let the homeowner know what they are and try to help come up with other options.

The homeowner's association appreciates all the hard work residents do to make their homes and the community beautiful. Keeping the Architectural Committee in the loop of all building projects keeps the Association looking great.
