# 2024 BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION SCHEDULE

- April 1 Candidate Applications will be available at the HOA office. If you would like an application to be emailed to you, please contact Marty or Gail at 928-772-7047 or the villages finance @gmail.com. (See below for Candidate Eligibility.)
- May 10 Deadline (Close of the Application Period) to return completed Candidate Applications to the HOA office and give them to a member of the office staff during their normal business hours. Eligible candidate names and resumes will be published in the June Crier.
- May 16 The Nominating Committee will host a "Meet the Candidates" forum, so that residents may ask questions directly to the candidates. This will follow the HOA meeting.
- May 20-June 18 Voting ballots are available at the HOA office during regular business hours for owners to pick up in person. You must wear your card key or show other identification indicating your lot number only one ballot per lot. You may not obtain the ballot for any other homeowner. Please read and follow the instructions included with your ballot, so that your ballot will not be disqualified. After completing your ballot, you may return it to the HOA office in person or send it via regular mail. We urge you to pick up your ballot and return it in person, to save on mailing expenses, and to assure that it is received by the deadline.
- June 19 The notice of the 2024 Annual Meeting and any remaining ballots not picked up in person will be mailed out to owners at their address of record. Make sure that our HOA records include your correct mailing address for you to receive your ballot in a timely manner.
- July 10 The Annual Meeting will begin at 2:00 p.m. Ballots received at the HOA office on or before 11:00 a.m. will be counted beginning at 11:30 a.m. until completed by the ballot-counting team of volunteers. Meeting attendees will have an opportunity to submit their ballot if they have not already done so. The results of the election will be announced at this meeting.
- CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY Per The Villages at Lynx Creek Owners Association Bylaws, Article VI, Section 2: "To be eligible as a candidate, a person must be an Owner in good standing for not less than twelve (12) months immediately preceding the close of the application period. Previous interrupted Ownership and/or residency or rental shall not apply toward this requirement." The phrase "in good standing" means that the owner is not more than thirty days in arrears in their monthly assessment and has not had their HOA membership suspended.



### **Architectural Committee**

In April many of us are thinking about the spring and summer landscaping for our yards. Here is what the Architectural Committee Rules have to say about the more significant changes you may have in mind. When your plans start taking form, give us a call to assist you with your plans.

LANDSCAPING CC&R 1.18; 1.21; 3.19; 7.2

The Villages require that landscaping be approved and completed within a reasonable time after all new construction is completed and occupancy takes place. (approximately ninety (90) days depending upon circumstances.

The following trees are NOT PERMITTED in The Villages because of excessive leaf drop, size, water requirements and/or affinity for sewer lines: Cottonwood, Willow, Maple, Arizona Cyprus, Raywood Ash and Sycamore For all other trees, the homeowner should be prepared to demonstrate the appropriateness of the tree they choose.

No shrubs or trees are to be planted in rear or side yards which, when mature, will encroach onto a neighboring lot and/or public right-of-way. Limbs or other parts of an existing tree or shrub which encroach onto a neighboring lot must be removed if Requested by the neighboring lot owner. Any shrubs or trees overhanging or encroaching on the public right-of-way must be maintained from the ground level of fourteen (14) feet. This meets fire truck clearance when the Department services our community.

The location of all trees, shrubs, or bushes that an owner wishes to plant near a street or driveway must be approved by the Architectural Committee. No tree or tall shrub may be planted within 15 feet of a street intersection or driveway to prevent vehicular traffic obstruction of view. Any trees or shrubs which currently present a safety hazard must be cut back or removed. Yard decorations cannot be so numerous as to create a cluttered look and must not present a nuisance to neighbors next door and across the street. Wall murals are not permitted. CC&R 1.18

Because of water spills during periods of heavy rain and when using landscape rock as a ground cover, the Committee requires the use of landscape breather type fabric underlayment in all situations where excessive runoff could damage neighboring properties. The underlayment is available at most nurseries and allows water to soak into the ground as well as providing weed prevention.
