MANAGER'S REPORT

Monday, October 13, 2024

Rich reported that the maintenance staff has complete 21 work orders turned in by residents. Joe was able to get all the common area landscaping trimmed. The dead tree behind the mailboxes was removed. The mailboxes will be cleaned and renumbered in October. The automatic gate on the North storage was installed with a keypad and the water valve covers are painted and numbered. The inside of the laundry room will be painted this winter.

Mike Brown reported that the Architectural Committee has processed 22 rfc's since the last meeting and 6 final inspections. There are 60 unreturned permits, so if you have a permit that you didn't turn back in, please bring it to the Association office. Richard Crowell is working on the CC&Rs for compliance with the Architectural rules. The Committee meets in the Architectural office each Wednesday at 9:00 and in the card room on the third Wednesday of the month

Mary Ann Schulte, President of the Recreation Committee, gave a report on the happenings for the next month which will be listed another place in the Crier. She reminded everyone that activities for 2025 must be resubmitted even if the activity is still the same. The deadline on October 30th. You must submit them to the Association Office.

The Budget Committee will be meeting on October 18th in the Library at 10:00

Veterans Memorial Brick Project

Residents may still honor a veteran or active-duty service member by purchasing an engraved 4"x8" Memorial Brick to be placed in the Veteran's Memorial area by the flagpole. Contact Charlie Davis (623-377-1833) with the inscription, up to three lines, not to exceed 20 characters per line (including punctuation and spaces). No insignia or graphics. You will be contacted to verify the inscriptions, collect \$35 per brick, and later notified when the brick has been received and installed.



WAVE THE FLAG PROJECT



All current requests for curbside American flags have had pipe installed. About 340 locations are ready for flags to be installed for Veterans Day.

NOTE: These pipe are for the display of the American flag ONLY. Anything else in a pipe will be removed.

Further installations have been suspended and will not resume until April in preparation for Memorial Day. Residents may still request flags for that phase by calling Charlie Davis or Larry Howe, or by forms in the office and Activity Room.

Donations will be collected in the office until Nov. 8th. Make checks payable to Villages at Lynx Creek; include "Flag Project" in the memo.

- About 4 veterans who helped install the 340+ pipe flag holders

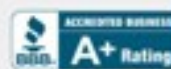

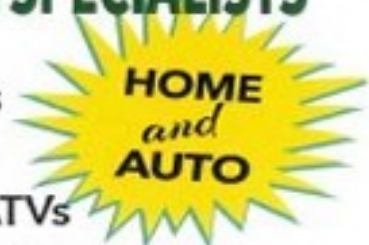

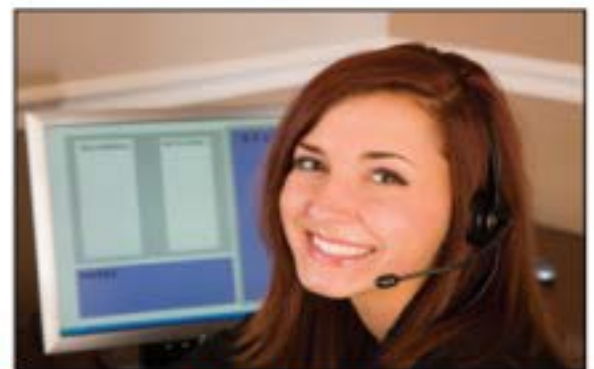
