
# POTATO FEST, MARCH 14TH

# LEAVES





Well, here it is February 2020 already! Spring is just around the corner and many of us will be improving our landscaping, repairing homes, and generally making improvements to our homes and lots. Everyone benefits from our lot improvements, for it shows pride in our community and improves our property values.

As a reminder, as you plan your home improvement projects on the outside of your homes don't forget to submit an RFC ("*Request For Change*") to the Architectural Committee (the RFCs are available at the Villages' office). We will be glad to help you so that your plans are fulfilled and comply with the CC&Rs. You may also need to get a *city permit* from the Town of Prescott Valley for some construction projects.

Don't' forget to consider the **legal setbacks** from property lines, **and easements** – check your copy of the "*Architectural Committee Rules*" and the *CC&Rs Sect. 3*. Also, your **structures** (house, carport/garage, patio/deck and porch covers) may have **a total** *roof coverage* of no more than 50% of your lot's square footage.

The Architectural Committee **meets every 1**<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesdays at 9:00 a.m., in the Card Room. <u>Your RFC needs to be turned in at the office by the Friday before our</u> <u>meetings</u>. You are also welcome to come and ask questions or just to observe.
