Beginning May 1st, all payments will be collected by The Villages at Lynx Creek. ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE NEWS "<u>The Virus Doesn't Affect Our RFCs</u>"

Well, isn't it wonderful that not everyone is sick with the Virus? A lot of folks are getting Cabin Fever though, and are getting things done outside, around the house. This is evident in the report that there are more people at Home Depot than usual. This is a good thing, <u>but don't forget to pick up a *Request For Change* form (aka, RFC) at the office. Just either call Lupe at the office, or knock on the office door, and Lupe will give you a form. After you fill out the *Request For Change*, <u>drop it in the office Mail Box slot</u> next to the door (on the wall at the right side of the door).</u>

The Architectural Committee will look over your *Request For Change* form, and issue the Villages' yellow Permit. This is to be placed where it can be seen from the street during the course of your project (in a window is fine). Please, DO NOT start working on your projects until you receive the Villages' yellow Permit. Also, any construction work over 4 feet high may need a Town of Prescott Valley permit, so check with them.

The CoronaVirus doesn't affect our RFCs. Even though the Villages' activities are shut down for a while, the Architectural Committee will still be working, to help you with your outside project plans (so that your plans will be in compliance with the CC&Rs (particularly section #3). <u>We will not be meeting with you at a regular meeting</u>, as before. <u>Instead</u>, we will look over your RFC, and contact you about approval or denial.

<u>HOWEVER</u>, IF your project <u>could</u> be delayed for a while, until the Virus problem eases up some more, the Committee would appreciate it.

<u>If you have questions you may call any of the members</u> of the Architectural Committee. They are: Rob Sheaffer, Bill Johnson, Silvia Cortez, Nancy Larson, John Black, Carl Shulak, and Rick Merrell. Our phone numbers and lot numbers are in the Villages' Directory. 


