

Weekly Update from the HOA Board,

We would like to update you all on some events that have taken place this week.

- Covid19 update – Yesterday evening, you heard a robocall announcing that we would be opening the facilities on Monday, August 3rd. The decision to close the facilities was done on the recommendation by our attorney. At that time, we had just experienced our second passing of a resident to the Covid19 virus. There were a lot of concerns that many people had recent contact both directly and indirectly with the resident. We deemed it necessary to take necessary precautions to minimize further exposure by closing our facilities for a 14day quarantine period. Here at the end of that quarantine period we have had no more known cases of the virus here in our community. We have posted signage at all entrances and exits of our facilities notifying you that you enter and use the facilities at your own risk. We can only ask you to wear masks when you are using the facilities however, we cannot enforce this request. Again, we understand that some residents may not agree with this decision and some may agree with the decision. We are facing a global threat for which there are no rules on what we should or should not do. Please take personal precautions to protect yourselves and your neighbors and be safe.
- Information Packets – Next week we will consider organizing volunteers to coordinate the gathering of the documents to be included in the packets.

We hope you stay safe and please be sure to wear your masks and badges everywhere in the community.
